Presidential Keynote Panels

Transcending Divisiveness: Depolarizing Practices from Around the Globe

Panelists share their experiences bridging 2 or more domains of research, practice, education, social justice and/or policy advocacy, and brainstorm initial recommendations to increase inclusive cross-collaborations.

This presentation covers the impact of trauma on children during the different phases of migration as well as the unique needs of second-generation immigrant children. Treatment strategies and vicarious trauma will also be discussed.

Prevention of Sexual Abuse and Promotion of Emotional Safety in Educational Settings

High school and college students often cite educators as primary sources of inspiration. Unfortunately, educators may also be sources of emotional stress and trauma. All presentations are geared toward increasing the sense of safety and protection from educator-induced stress and trauma for young people in educational settings.
